## Facility

Sampson House is the largest recovery centre in Europe and is equipped with 6 x 2.2 MVA generators with a fuel capacity to sustain a raw mains outage for 30 days. This is backed by full uninterruptible power supply (UPS) capacity, which is split per floor or by dedicated data centre. The centre also boasts an auditorium, a board room, 12 meeting rooms and rest room facilities.

## Positions

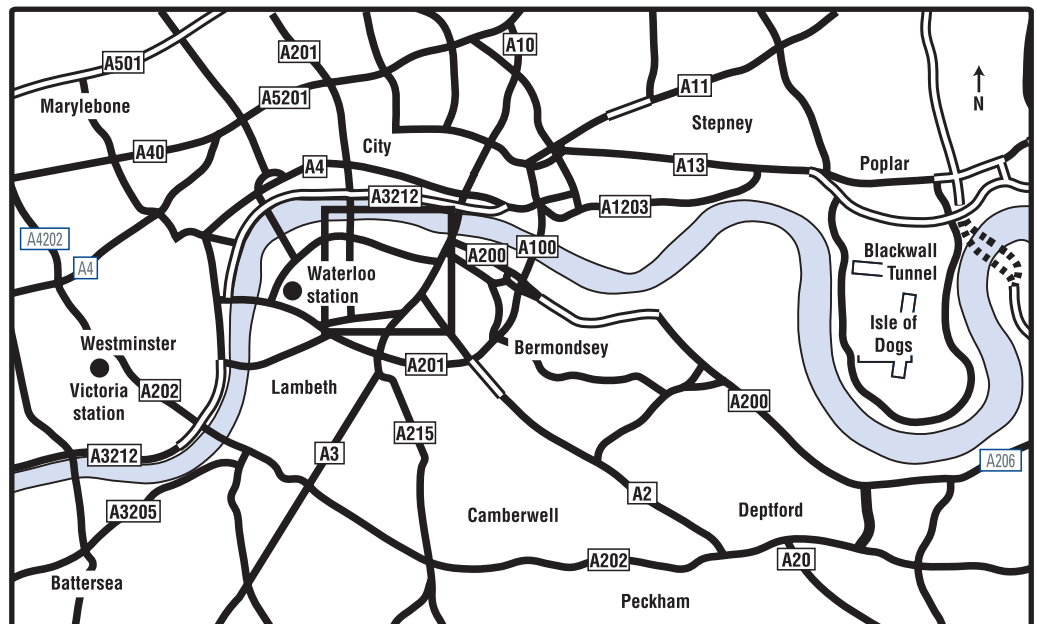
Currently the facility offers 695 dealing and 795 back office shared positions and a total of 906 dedicated positions. Each position is equipped with a PC and flat screens and all dealing positions have voice recording.

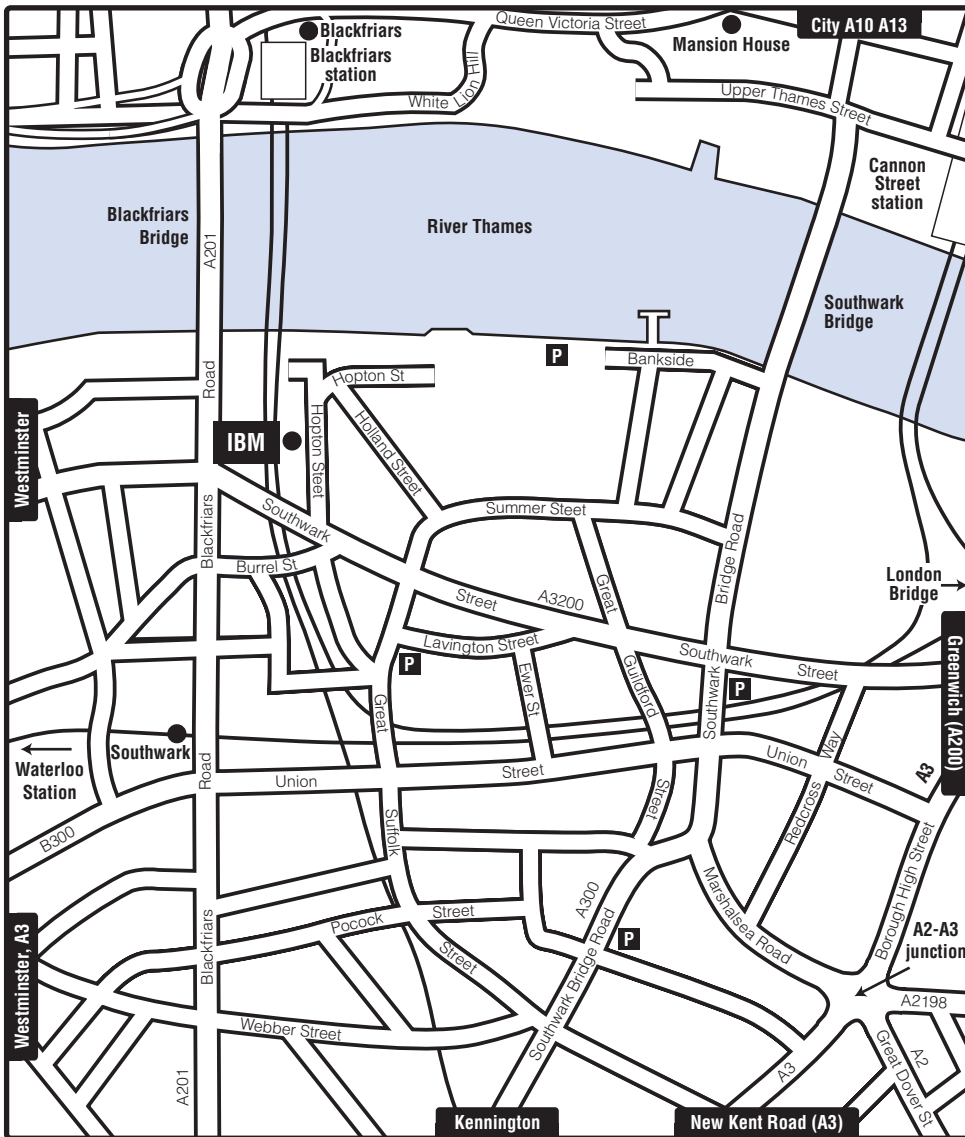
## Data centre and infrastructure

A total of 65,000 square feet of data centre has been built to a specification that exceeds the current market standard. These range from communications centres to full production back up facilities. These centres are built to customer specification within an eight to twelve week build time. Both the positions and data centres can be linked with the 1gb cabling infrastructure with CISCO switches.

## Support

The facility is supported by a team of experienced technical, communications and facilities staff totally dedicated to clients' business continuity needs.





**Car**

- *From the north:* Cross the River Thames at either Blackfriars Bridge or Southwark Bridge. Turn on to Southwark Street. Turn into Hopton Street and the recovery centre is on the left.
- *From the City/East:* Cross the River Thames at London Bridge. Filter right on to Southwark Street at the junction with A3 (Borough High Street). Turn into Hopton Street and the recovery centre is on the left.
- *From south and west, via the A3:* Follow signs for Southwark Bridge or Blackfriars Bridge. Turn on to Southwark Street. Turn into Hopton Street and the recovery centre is on the left.

**Rail**

The nearest underground station is Southwark, on the Jubilee line. Waterloo, Blackfriars and London Bridge stations are all within a short walk of Sampson House.

**Bus**

Southwark Street is served by route 381, running between Waterloo and Peckham bus station.

**Air**

19 miles from Heathrow, 29 miles from Gatwick and seven miles from London City Airport.
